The special section will be devoted to “lo cómico” in the Caribbean. The general section will encompass works from all literary and cultural periods pertaining to the Hispanic Caribbean. Articles should be unpublished, original, and of high academic standard. Essays should not exceed 25 pages. Please send your articles in attachment to:

Articles must be received before November 15, 2010 in order to be considered for publication in this issue.

All articles must appear in Microsoft Word format. Any articles not following this format will not be considered. Then submit the *.doc file as an e-mail attachment.

Articles must adhere to the following format: Header, Body text, Notes, Bibliography.

Please do not create separate sections, divisions or font changes – the simpler the better since all files will be converted to HTML format.

All text must appear using font type—Palatino Linotype, 12 points.

Authors are asked to adhere to the following format:

Header:

Line 1: Title

Line 2: author

Line 3: affiliation

Line 4: blank.

Body text:

All paragraphs should be single-spaced. Do not indent and please leave a space between paragraphs.

Long quotes or poems should be indented as a whole paragraph. Please format numbers of notes as superscript.

Notes:

All notes must be in numerical order and correspond with the footnote numbers in the text.

Numbers should appear formatted in parentheses and each note should be considered a single paragraph using the same font as above. When in doubt, follow MLA style sheet rules regarding quotation marks and italics.

Do not skip lines between notes.

Bibliography:

All items must be in alphabetical order by author, or journal and we expect authors to follow MLA style sheet rules regarding quotation marks and italics, etc.

Each item should be considered a single paragraph, same font as above.

Please leave a space between items.

Photos and paintings:

All photos must be in .jpg or .gif format and please do not include them within the Word document.
